

Council has developed a plan that will loosen some of our current COVID-19 restrictions based on the increased number of people vaccinated and the resulting decrease in reported cases. These revisions include:



- o Members may enter through the main doors.
- o Social distancing practices will continue.
- o There will not be a temperature screening at the door, but members should continue to do the self-screening for symptoms prior to attending indoor worship.
- o Once seated in the Sanctuary, fully vaccinated members may remove their masks if they choose to do so.
- o Full liturgy will resume, including a children's sermon.
- o Singing of Hymns will resume.
- o Sharing of the Peace will continue to be done in sign language.
- o Communion will continue in the pew.

Worship will remain at 9 AM. The option of attending from the parking lot will continue, as well as the recording of the service, and the Home Worship Ideas that are distributed weekly for members who prefer to continue to worship at home.
